**ACCEPTANCE FORM**

By signing below, the scholar accepts the award and agrees to meet the following expectations of the Weill-Cornell Program:

- Commit at least 8 weeks (June 18-August 10) to conducting aging research under supervision of a faculty member.
- Attend mandatory didactic seminars on Tuesday and Thursday mornings.
- Attend mandatory clinical rotations (usually Tuesday afternoons).
- Discuss a journal article related to their research during one of the Tuesday morning sessions.
- Schedule mid-term and exit interviews with Drs. LoFaso and Capello.
- Make a 15-minute oral presentation of their research on August 9, 2007, to Cornell faculty, peers, and other invited guests. If the actual research project has not been completed by that date, students will present on their progress to-date.
- Submit a written report (journal-style article, approximately 8-10 pages) 3 months after the conclusion of the 2007 Summer Program – due November 14 to Drs. Capello & LoFaso (and also AFAR).
- Submit an abstract of their research for poster presentation during the Weill Cornell Research Day.
- Submit an abstract of their research for poster presentation at the 2007 Annual Meeting of the American Geriatrics Society – May 1-4 in Washington, D.C. Abstract deadline is usually the first week in December.
- Students are also to present their poster at the AGS student Poster session, Saturday May 3.
